Evaluation Rubric for Clinical Behavior Analyst Portfolio

Overall Evaluation: Pass Fail

If applicants do not meet criteria, they may revise with guidance from the SATÍS Assessment Committee.

Two of three committee members review each portfolio. External reviewers may be consulted.

Each reviewer evaluates independently, then meets to compare results.
